He reported that he had done so and advised the Council that the changes were an improvement and had tidied up the area.</p> <p>The large mirror on the common in the centre of the village had been noted. No permission had been sought and the owners were to be approached to remove it. It was further thought that permission had not been sought from SCC for the dropped kerb.</p>
