14/15: 026CC	<p><u>ELMBRIDGE HOUSE TREES</u> Cllr Enticknap reported that the tree works at Elmbridge House were scheduled to be done in March.</p>	
14/15: 027CC	<p><u>RPA REGISTRATION</u> The Clerk reported that the Petra Billings, SWT, has the required forms and will apply for any grants as soon as they are open.</p>	
14/15: 028CC	<p><u>COMMONS CUT</u> Cllr Enticknap reported that there would be no further cuts on the common.</p>	
14/15: 029CC	<p><u>REPORT FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMONS STEERING GROUP</u> Cllr Enticknap reported that the ponds at Elm Corner and the KGV pond both require maintenance work. At the Elm Corner pond, the shrub called Spirea has overgrown and needs to be cut down and the stumps to be ground down. Further to this the willow also needs to be cleared. This will need to be done in Spring as the swans were still in residence at the pond. Cllr Enticknap recommended that the KGV pond needs the willow removing and this should be done in Autumn. Cllr Enticknap reported that the works at the School pond were almost complete at a cost of £3000. The pond known as Stan's pond was successfully filling with rain water. The Wrotham Hill pond needs the reeds pulling but this would have to wait until the works at the Elm Corner and KGV ponds were completed. Cllr Enticknap also reported that Rick Walker would clear the path behind the cricket pitch and also cut the ivy on the bottom of the trees around the village.</p>
